The Essay:

Essay Introductions Include:

- 1. Topic Sentence
- 2. Listing of main ideas.
- 3. State the thesis.
- 4. Concluding Sentence/ Transition Sentence.

Essay Bodies Include:

- 1. Topic Sentence
- 2. State the main point.
- 3. Support for the main point. (Quotes, Statistics, Anecdotes, Testimonials, Examples, other)
- 4. Explanation of the support and how it contributes to your main point.
- 5. Second support for main point.
- 6. Explanation of the support and how it contributes to your main point.
- 7. Repeat (as needed)
- 8. Concluding Sentence/Transition Sentence.

Essay Conclusions Include:

- 1. Topic Sentence.
- 2. Referencing to the thesis.
- 3. Summarize your final conclusion about the thesis.
- 4. Question, extend your thought, analyze, challenge your reader or look to the future.

Formatting (MLA):

- Italics for titles.
- MLA header consisting of student's name, teacher's name, Class code and date. Header needs to be doubled spaced.
- Last name and page number should not be on the first page.
- Times New Roman Font 12 point.
- White paper only.
- Only one space between paragraphs.
- Do not allow one sentence on the next page (paragraph format)
- Punctuation after a quote period after reference bracket.
- Reference bracket (last name, number) no p. before the number.
- Consistent indentation after paragraphs.
- One space after each period.
